Member(s), hereby agrees to release and hold harmless, and to further refrain from asserting claims, disputes or litigation of any kind against Cedar Valley Riders; Optimist Club of Ashland, Inc., the Ashland Optimist Foundation, and each respective organization’s officers, directors, members, volunteers, affiliated organizations and others acting on its behalf (hereinafter referred to collectively as “the Released Parties”), for any claim or damages of any nature to Members and/or Members’ personal property, which arises in any manner from use of the Arena and/or any other Club activity, on or off- premises, including those instances arising from the alleged negligence of the Released Parties.

II. STATUTORY WARNING.

Member has additionally been advised of and accepts those risks outlined in RSMo §537.325, which reads:

WARNING

Under Missouri law, an equine activity sponsor, an equine professional, a livestock activity sponsor, a livestock owner, a livestock facility, a livestock auction market, or any employee thereof is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine or livestock activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine or livestock activities pursuant to the Revised Statutes of Missouri. III. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

As a condition precedent of membership acceptance, Member expressly consents to the submission of any dispute arising out of this Membership agreement and/or Club activities of any kind to binding arbitration, said arbitration to be held before a neutral arbitrator mutually selected by the parties, with each party bearing its own costs.
